



There are three categories of CFDA membership. After CFDA Board approval of an application, you will, regardless of your membership category, have access to all of the privileges, rights and benefits of membership as described throughout this membership package and in the by-laws of the association. By signing the application, you agree that you and your firm will observe and abide by CFDA's Code of Ethics.

The Board of Directors of CFDA determines fees and dues for membership.

New Member Fee

All new members are assessed a one-time application fee of \$75.00.

Regular Member Dues

This category of membership is for funeral home firms located in California. The annual dues are calculated using a base fee plus a fee per death certificate filed with the state of California during the previous year, excluding fetal deaths and transports.

*Base Fee: \$ 250.00
Additional Fee: \$ 1.05/death certificate
Maximum dues amount not to exceed \$10,000.*

Special Member Dues

*Non-funeral home businesses providing goods and services related to the funeral industry may join **CFDA** under the category of Special Member.*

Dues for these members are determined by their preceding year's gross annual sales.

*Annual sales up to
\$500,000 \$ 200.00*

*Annual sales between
\$500,001 to \$1 million \$ 325.00*

*Annual sales exceeding
\$1 million \$ 450.00*

Associate Member Dues

This category of membership is open to all funeral homes located outside the state of California. Annual dues for membership under this category are \$125.00.
